## **DAGSI FUNDING**

- 26 consecutive years of Ohio funding since 1996.
- Increase student stipends to remain competitive.
- Leverage the increase in demand for graduate student research by AFRI
- Fund more projects annually to develop research talent to meet AFRL and Ohio high-tech workforce needs.
- 2023-2025 state funding requirement of \$2.2M/yr.

#### AFRL/DAGSI Research Program Success Measures (6/6/2022)

- o Program was first funded by Ohio in 1999, with 453 projects sponsored to date
- Research is undertaken by students and faculty on topics defined by AFRL, using AFRL and university facilities and resources
- o Program is open to teams from any Ohio research university
- State funding totals \$44.5 million since 1999
- 1999-2003 (Total of \$16.2 million in State funding): 48 collaborative projects funded, with approximately 200 Ohio faculty and 230 students involved
- 2004-present (\$1.6 million/yr state funding in FY21): 330 projects awarded DAGSI funding in the annual competitive round, each fellowship supporting one student and one faculty member
- 70% of graduates are employed in Ohio industry, academic, and government lab positions
- AFRL has hired at least 23 students who held AFRL/DAGSI fellowships, plus many others working for local businesses that contract with AFRL
- The first AFRL/DAGSI Cooperative Agreement was signed in August of 2012, providing a vehicle for cost share by AFRL
  - Almost \$3 million was obligated by AFRL
  - 54 projects have received AFRL funding; including 23 that have been fully funded by AFRL
- The new AFRL/DAGSI Cooperative Agreement was signed in January of 2019, providing a vehicle for cost share by AFRL and opening funding opportunities for graduate and undergraduate interns across AFRL
  - o To date more than \$5.1 million has been obligated by AFRL
  - 70 projects have received AFRL funding; including 52 that have been fully funded by AFRL
    - Out of state funded projects through:
      - Georgia Tech Research Corporation
      - University of Kansas Center for Research
      - Tennessee Technical University
      - Texas A&M University
      - University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign
      - University of Connecticut
  - Summer 2020 marked the beginning of the SOCHE Intern program in AFRL
    - To date, more than \$632K has been obligated
    - Total of 58 interns in AFRL/RG, AFRL/RH, AFRL/RQ and AFRL/RY
