RiverScape Paddling

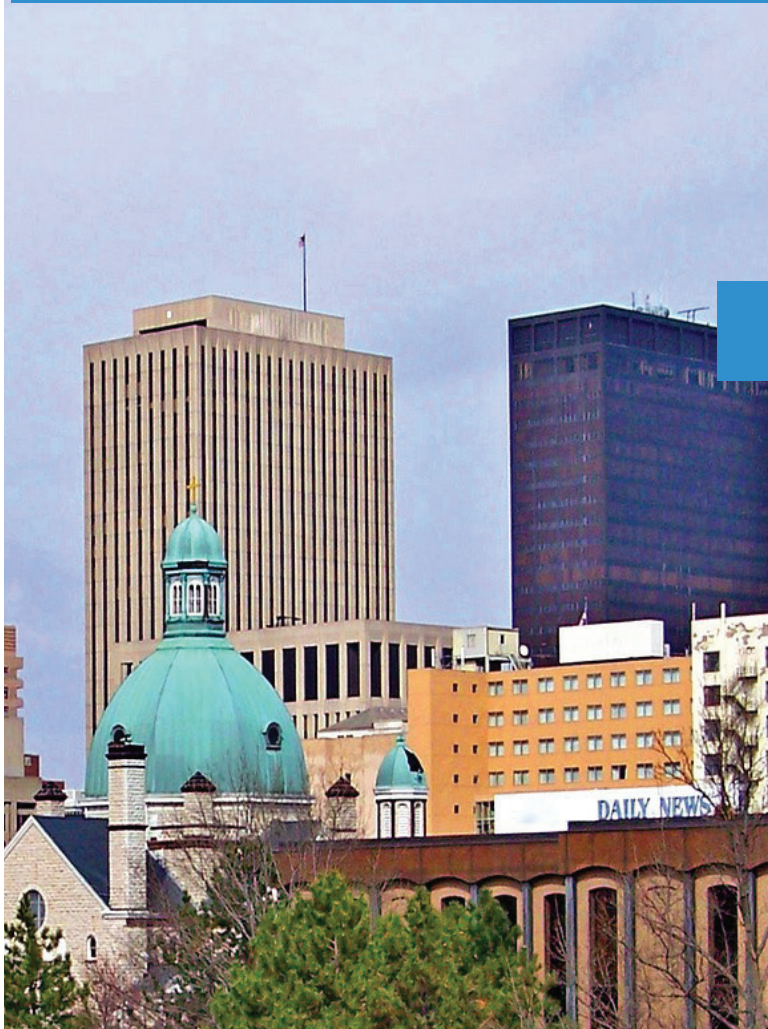

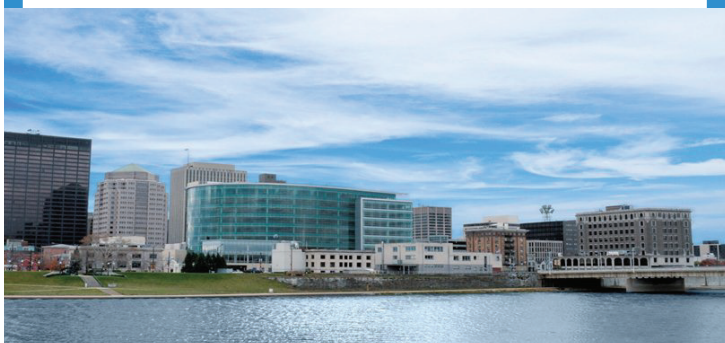
