The Gem City Chapter, ABWA is looking for eligible applicants to sponsor for consideration of a \$1,000 Impact Scholarship from the Stephen Bufton Memorial Educational Fund of the American Business Women's Association. The Impact Scholarship Program offers college students attending a 4-year accredited college or university a scholarship that helps to offset costs associated with their college tuition, books, and fees.

Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

- Female, U.S. citizen and seeking a Baccalaureate degree or higher.
- ABWA members and non-members, including high school seniors, may apply for an Impact scholarship.
- Resident of these Ohio counties: Montgomery, Miami, Clark, Greene, Butler, Preble, Darke and Warren
- Any Field of Study
- Min 2.8 GPA
- Any # credit hours
- Any School
- Must complete an online application (link will be provided) and submit an official transcript, a biographical sketch and three (3) professional letters of reference dated in the same year as her application.
- A minimum of three (3) eligible completed applications are required for the scholarship to be awarded.
- Scholarship recipient will be notified in July 2026.
- The Gem City Chapter will sponsor the 2026 recipient for a one-year student membership (\$50 value) in the American Business Women's Association and the Gem City Chapter, which meets on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. See www.abwagemcity.org for monthly meeting details.

Next Steps:

Eligible applicants must send an email with "ABWA Impact Scholarship" and your name in the subject line. Include the following in your email: Your name, email address, phone number, mailing address, state of your primary residence, GPA, credit hours completed and name of the school you will be attending in the fall of 2026.

We will contact you with information on how to submit the remaining required documents. The application and all supporting documents must be completed and submitted online by 4/30/2026.

Additional Information:

Each scholarship awarded is for one academic year only and is not renewable. Funds awarded may be used for tuition, books, and fees. Unused funds must be returned to SBMEF. Checks for scholarships are made payable to the educational institution and the applicant jointly and must be cashed within 6 months of issuance. No applicant is guaranteed a scholarship. Our chapter sponsors applicants for consideration by the SBMEF Board of trustees. The SBMEF Board of Trustees serves as the selection board for awarding all scholarships.
